Omaha Student Awarded Top National VFW Scholarship

Omaha Student Awarded Top National VFW Scholarship

Kumar awarded first place, \$30,000 scholarship prize out of more than 51,000 entries

WASHINGTON (March 3, 2020) – The Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) is proud to announce Shruthi Kumar, a senior at Marian High School in Omaha, Nebraska, was named first place national winner and recipient of the \$30,000 T.C. Selman Memorial Scholarship award in its 2019-2020 Voice of Democracy scholarship program.

The announcement was made during last night's Parade of Winners ceremony at the 2020 VFW Legislative Conference in Washington, D.C., where Shruthi was presented with her \$30,000 award and delivered her winning speech. VFW Post 1581 in Omaha, Nebraska, sponsored Shruthi.

"The more than \$200,000 awarded tonight makes a grand total of \$3 million presented at the national, state and local levels of our competitions, and I know will help ensure the doors of opportunity are opened wide for this talented group of young people," said VFW National Commander William "Doc" Schmitz.

Open to eligible high school students in grades 9 through 12, the VFW's annual Voice of Democracy audio-essay program requires entrants to write and record a three- to five-minute script on a democratic, patriotic theme. This year more than 51,000 high school students from across the world reflected on the theme "What Makes America Great," with national finalists competing for their share of \$154,000 in scholarships and awards. VFW Post 1581 Auxiliary

o Need 15 members to start o 16 years and up. o There is a \$25.00 fee per year. **Start a new Auxiliary**

When you start a new Auxiliary, you're not just increasing the VFW Auxiliary's membership. You're expanding our ability to serve veterans, active-duty military and their families while promoting patriotism in your community.

Whether a VFW Post decides on its own that it wants an Auxiliary or whether a member or non-member sees the potential for a new Auxiliary, the steps for creating an Auxiliary are the same:

A VFW Post must vote by 2/3 majority to have an Auxiliary. (An Auxiliary can never exist on its own without a Post and can never be started without that Post's permission).

The Department (state) President appoints the official organizer of that Auxiliary and he/she must be a member of the VFW Auxiliary.

A minimum of 15 eligible applicants must be on the application for the Charter (transfers are not eligible).

Eligibility Requirements for VFW Auxiliary Membership:

Members must be citizens of the United States or a United States National, and at least 16 years old.

Those eligible are:

- ·Husband/Wife
- ·Widower/Widow
- ·Father/Mother
- ·Grandfathers/Grandmothers
- ·Sons/Daughters
- ·Grandsons/Granddaughters
- ·Brothers/Sisters

Of persons who were or are eligible for membership in the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States. Those eligible for membership in the VFW are those that have received a campaign medal for overseas service; have served 30 consecutive or 60 non-consecutive days in Korea; or have ever received hostile fire or imminent danger pay.

Step and adopted parents, children, siblings (and half-siblings), grandparents and grandchildren are considered the same as biological parents, children, siblings, grandparents and grandchildren and may join the VFW Auxiliary under their VFW-eligible veteran. Proof of service is required for eligibility and must be obtained by the applicant.
