VFW Post 1581 works with Boy Scout Troop 408 on other project and attended this event at the Eastern Nebraska Veterans' Home. Drew Grandgenett is a Boy Scout with Troop 408. Troop 408 is affiliated with St. Wenceslaus Catholic Church in Omaha. Drew is a senior attending Millard West High School. Drew is currently a "Life" rank scout and working towards his "Eagle" rank. To attain the Eagle Rank, a Boy Scout must lead a service project that benefits a group in the community other than Boy Scouts of America. For the first part of the project, Drew sought and received donations from family, friends, and other veterans related organizations to purchase enough fabric and supplies to make a military themed "tie blanket" for each of the 115 members residing at ENVH. The blankets are approximately 5 feet by 5 feet in size and are made from two pieces of fleece fabric. One piece has a military pattern for the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, or Coast Guard and the other piece is a solid color.

Drew Grandgenett lead volunteer scouts and parents who were at ENVH and Drew gave a short speech and then the blankets were picked up by or delivered to the members. Each of the members living at ENVH received a blanket with one side bearing the design of the branch of the service that the member (or the member's spouse) was in as a thank you gift for the veteran's service to our country.

Drew thought this project would be a nice way for him, his fellow scouts, and everyone who helped him to honor and thank the residents of ENVH that have faithfully served and protected our country and helped to provide the wonderful "blanket of freedom" that all Americans live under.

John Hilgert, Jr. Vice Commander of VFW Post 1581 is an Assistant Scoutmaster with Troop 408 and has been kind enough to serve as a mentor for Drew for his project.
